End User License Agreement

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE INSTALLING THE PROGRAM.

Ascolog GmbH's End User License Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity, referred to as "licensee") and Ascolog GmbH (referred to as "licenser") for the software product **Ascolog Insight Professional** which may include associated software components, media, printed materials, and "online" or electronic documentation. These items are referred to as "SOFTWARE PRODUCT" in this document. By installing, copying, or otherwise using the SOFTWARE PRODUCT, you agree to be bound by the terms of this EULA. This license agreement represents the entire agreement concerning the SOFTWARE PRODUCT between you and Ascolog GmbH and it supersedes any prior proposal, representation, or understanding between the parties. If you do not agree to the terms of this EULA, do not install or use the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is protected by copyright laws and international copyright treaties, as well as other intellectual property laws and treaties. The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is licensed, not sold, it is owned by Ascolog GmbH.

You must comply with all applicable laws regarding the use of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT. Your use of this software and any dispute arising out of such use is subject to the laws of Austria and any dispute shall be resolved by the jurisdiction of a court at Ascolog GmbH's place of business.

The SOFTWARE PRODUCT is licensed as follows:

(a) Grant of License

The following license types are available for the SOFTWARE PRODUCT:

- Full license
- Trial license

Note: Purchasing an Ascolog Insight Professional license does not entitle you to use the Ascolog Insight SDK or to run Ascolog Insight as a Windows® service.

Full License

For each full license you acquire you may use one copy of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT on one assigned device. The license is assigned to a device until you uninstall the SOFTWARE PRODUCT. You can reassign a license to a different device when 30 days since the last assignment have elapsed or when the device cannot be used anymore due to a hardware failure. You must activate the SOFTWARE PRODUCT by providing the SOFTWARE PRODUCT with a license key. You may also make copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT as they may be necessary for backup and archival purposes.

Example: If you want to install the SOFTWARE PRODUCT on a personal computer and a USB stick

concurrently you have to purchase two licenses.

Trial License

A trial license grants you the right to use this software for evaluation purposes without charge. Your rights to use trial software are limited to the trial period. You must activate the software by providing a license key. The trial software and length of the trial period are set forth during the activation process. After this period the software will not run. To continue to operate the software you will be required to purchase a full license. Evaluation versions available for download from Ascolog GmbH's website may be freely distributed under the terms of this agreement. It is prohibited to distribute license keys.

Alternative Versions and Multiplexing (Pooling)

The software may include more than one version, such as 32-bit and 64-bit. You may use only one version at one time.

Hardware or software you use to pool connections, to reroute information or to reduce the number of devices or users that directly access or use the software does not reduce the number of licenses that you need.

(b) Upgrades and Updates

If the SOFTWARE PRODUCT is an upgrade from an earlier release, you now may use that upgraded product only in accordance with this EULA. You do not acquire another license when you upgrade the SOFTWARE PRODUCT. As a consequence you do not have the permission to run the original and the upgraded SOFTWARE PRODUCT on different devices.

Ascolog GmbH may provide you with support services related to the SOFTWARE PRODUCT. Any supplemental software code provided to you as part of the support services shall be considered part of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT and subject to the terms and conditions of this EULA.

(c) Distribution and Transfer

You may not distribute registered copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT to third parties. You may not rent, lease, or lend the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

However, you may make a one-time transfer of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT and this agreement to a third party. You must not retain a copy of the transferred software. The other party must agree that this agreement applies to the transfer and use of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT. If the SOFTWARE PRODUCT is an upgrade, any transfer must also include all prior versions of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT.

(d) Reverse Engineering

You may terminate this License at any time by destroying all copies of the SOFTWARE PRODUCT and its documentation.
